Mission Personnel

Mission personnel are generally professional (exempt) lay employees employed by the World Mission Division (WMD). Mission Personnel can also be clergy. Most missionaries who enroll in the Plan are employed through the WMD and are enrolled for medical coverage, pension, death, and disability benefits. A lay missionary member can enroll for Plan participation based on employment in any eligible service (e.g. employment by a governing body or a church).

Mission personnel can be enrolled for individual Plan membership or, if both members of a married couple are employed by WMD, they can be enrolled as member couples. . .
