Disability benefits may be initiated retroactively to the 91st day of the disability if **all** the following requirements are met:

- The Member was "currently protected," with death and disability coverage, at the onset of the disability.
- The Member provides acceptable medical evidence of disability from the time he or she initially qualifies for benefits.
- The Board receives the application for disability benefits within 12 months of the onset of the disability.
- The employer has not provided more than 40% of the former effective salary (pro-rated for the retro period) to the member for any period beyond the 90-day waiting period.
